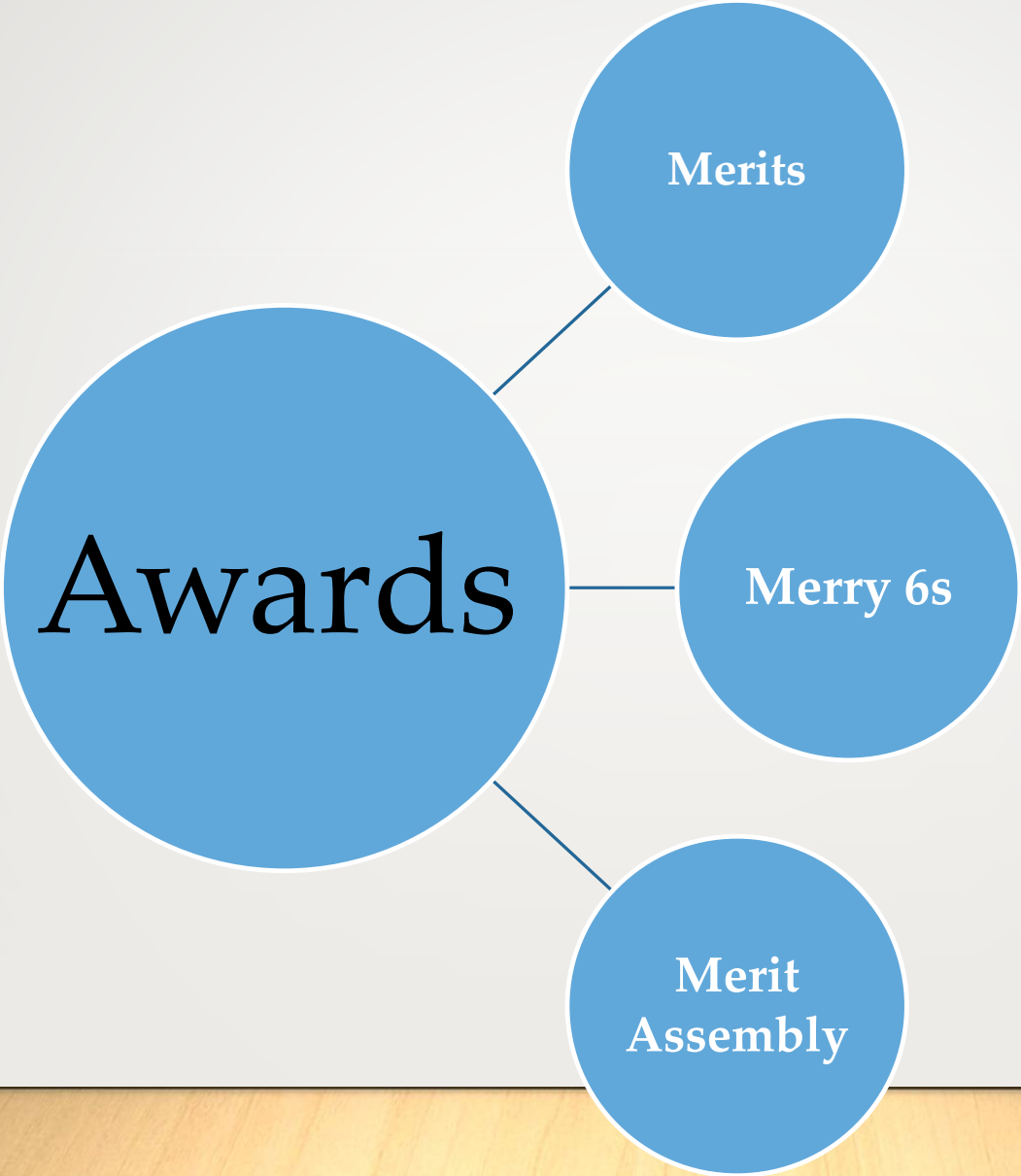


Awards at Merrylands High School

Awards:

MERRY 6s:

Students earn Merry 6s by demonstrating expected behaviours.
